School fees are a statutory duty in terms of the South African Schools Act No. 48 of 1996. The school fees for 2025 are R49 000 for all grades. An increase of approximately 10% on school fees is expected for 2026.

Meaning of Quintile 5: These are fee-paying schools. They receive meagre funding from the government and cannot afford to run the school on those funds alone. Quintile 5 schools rely on a school fee paying parent base which enables the school to employ skilled educators, to offer a wide range of extra-mural activities and thereby promote a high quality of holistic education.

It is only by paying school fees that Jeppe High School for Girls can offer a premium education to every learner.
